## 2010: The Year of Hospitality

*"Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for by doing that some have entertained angels without knowing it."* Hebrews 13:2

The year 2010 began with hope that the recession of previous years would end and life would return to "normal." Unfortunately, in Oregon that was not to be the case. Our unemployment rate was above the national average, and in some counties in Oregon it exceeded 15 percent. The increase in home foreclosure rates put Oregon number three in the nation behind Nevada and Florida. And Oregon remained in the top five of the hungriest states in the nation.

In the midst of so much poverty and uncertainty about the future, churches, denominations and other faith communities were also addressing their own challenges. While the unemployment and financial reverses forced more people to turn to the faith community for help, many religious communities faced their own severe budget challenges. Churches and denominations were forced to cut back financially, resulting in reductions in religious and community ministries and services.

Yet amidst all these challenges, Oregon's religious community continued to reach out to those in need as a healing and serving presence. This was vividly evident at the *2010 Ecumenical Ministries of Oregon (EMO) Annual Community Awards and Celebration Dinner*, held on May 25. On that evening, some 400 representatives of the diverse religious communities in Oregon came to lift up the transformative power of the radical, faith-filled hospitality that leads to feeding the hungry, standing up to hate movements, advocating for those living on the margins of society, and joining together to serve and help all who suffer. The people and religious organizations honored that evening gave testament to the strength of the ecumenical movement and the transforming power of serving together in faith.

Ecumenical Ministries of Oregon is blessed to be born out of this movement, and to be sustainers of the movement during both prosperous and difficult times. Through the collective commitment of so many faith communities and people of faith, we are able to keep central Jesus' vision of unity in community. Through our supporters and partners in ecumenism, we are able to focus on the importance of compassionate ministries and justice-filled advocacy in service to God's people and creation.

While we too faced challenges at EMO, we were strengthened and sustained by thousands across Oregon working together to make hope real in a time of so much uncertainty and despair.

On behalf of the communities and people that make EMO such an extraordinary organization, we thank you for your faithful support and give thanks to God for the opportunity to serve in the spirit of Christ in this part of God's creation.





The **Patton Home** offered residents weekly movie nights and game sessions, hot meals, monthly bus trips for local grocery and clothes shopping, as well as an annual trip to Seaside ■ **Shared Housing** completed 200 housing matches, providing 1,624 months of housing for 237 clients; the **Beaverton Youth Second Home** project assisted 20 unaccompanied, homeless students.

## Affordable Housing

**Ecumenical Ministries of Oregon** has a long history of developing and advocating for affordable housing and is dedicated to filling the housing needs of those less fortunate by providing the services listed below.

**Patton Home** is a beautiful and gracious 100-year old single-room occupancy residence in north Portland offering drug- and alcohol-free housing for up to 63 low-income residents.

**Shared Housing** provides affordable housing opportunities through a referral and matching service, bringing together those who need affordable housing with people who have homes and need help with rent, household chores or personal care.



In June, EMO organized the "Interfaith Summit on Homeless Children, Youth & Families," held in Salem and attended by over 250 people.

## Hunger, Nutrition & Social Support

*Serving communities in crisis and people in need is central to EMO's basic human needs programs, which are listed below.*

**Food Services/Delizioso Catering** prepares nutritious meals for clients at the HIV Day Center and Daily Bread Express, residents at the Patton Home and students at local schools. The program also runs a catering service, providing outstanding and affordable food for events.

**HIV Services** offers a wide range of assistance for people living with HIV/AIDS. The HIV Day Center provides meals, counseling, recreational therapy, computers, phones, laundry, clothing and showers. The Daily Bread Express is the only program in Portland that delivers meals to home-bound individuals living with HIV/AIDS.

**Northeast Emergency Food Program** (NEFP) provides nutritionally-balanced food for people in critical need and works to develop neighborhood-based solutions to secure access to adequate, affordable and healthy foods.

**Hunger, Nutrition & Social Support in 2010 ... Food Services/Delizioso Catering** produced 44,370 meals (275 per day) for HIV Day Center and Daily Bread Express clients, Patton Home residents, and students at four local schools; transformed 250-square-feet of unused land near the kitchen into a raised-bed vegetable garden ■ **HIV Day Center and Daily Bread Express** served 338 clients; 7,452 visits were made to the HIV Day Center; 8,565 meals were delivered to home-bound individuals living with HIV/AIDS ■ **Northeast Emergency Food Program** provided a five-day supply of food and household items to 7,741 families, representing 24,636 individuals—the highest in the program's history; 240 NEFP volunteers donated over 10,000 hours of their time.
