### Mission Statement

The mission of Ecumenical Ministries of Oregon is to bring together Oregon's diverse faith community for dialogue, advocacy and community ministries in service to God's people and creation.

### Categories of Membership and Dues Structure

As a covenantal membership association, all members are expected to support EMO financially. Financial support provides the means to successfully carry out the mission of EMO and agreed upon ministries and services. Recommended annual membership dues, designated for the annual fund are as follows:

- Denominational: \$75-100 per congregation in judicatory
- Congregational: \$1 per adult member, with a \$100 minimum
- Ecumenical and Interfaith Cooperative Organizations: \$200
