These informative and entertaining (yes, we do have a few laughs along the way) workshops include a coffee break to allow time to network and plan. During those three hours, we will address:

- What's a Cool Congregations program?
- ABCs of climate change.
- Why we care about this in our congregation: The religious response to climate change.
- Measure your own carbon footprint and find ways to reduce it.
- How to organize a Cool Congregations program in your congregation.
- Begin plans to start your own Cool Congregations program.
- The Other Side of the Meter: local, state and federal policies on energy and global warming.

- CD of resources for success, including our specially designed computer program to calculate global warming pollution emissions from your activities and Oregon-specific.

- Line-dried 5 of the 14 loads of laundry they do each week.

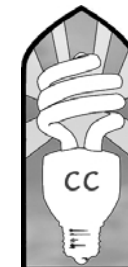
