Clean River Rewards

- Only City of Portland stormwater utility ratepayers are eligible (not every property in Portland pays stormwater utility fees)
- Ratepayer (not always the property owner) will receive the discount
- Ongoing discounts on the onsite stormwater management fee
 - Up to 100% discount for managing stormwater onsite
 - Sliding scale and pro-rated for partial or flow-through systems
 - Residential accounts: up to \$7/month
 - MFR/Commercial accounts: up to \$3/1,000 ft²/month

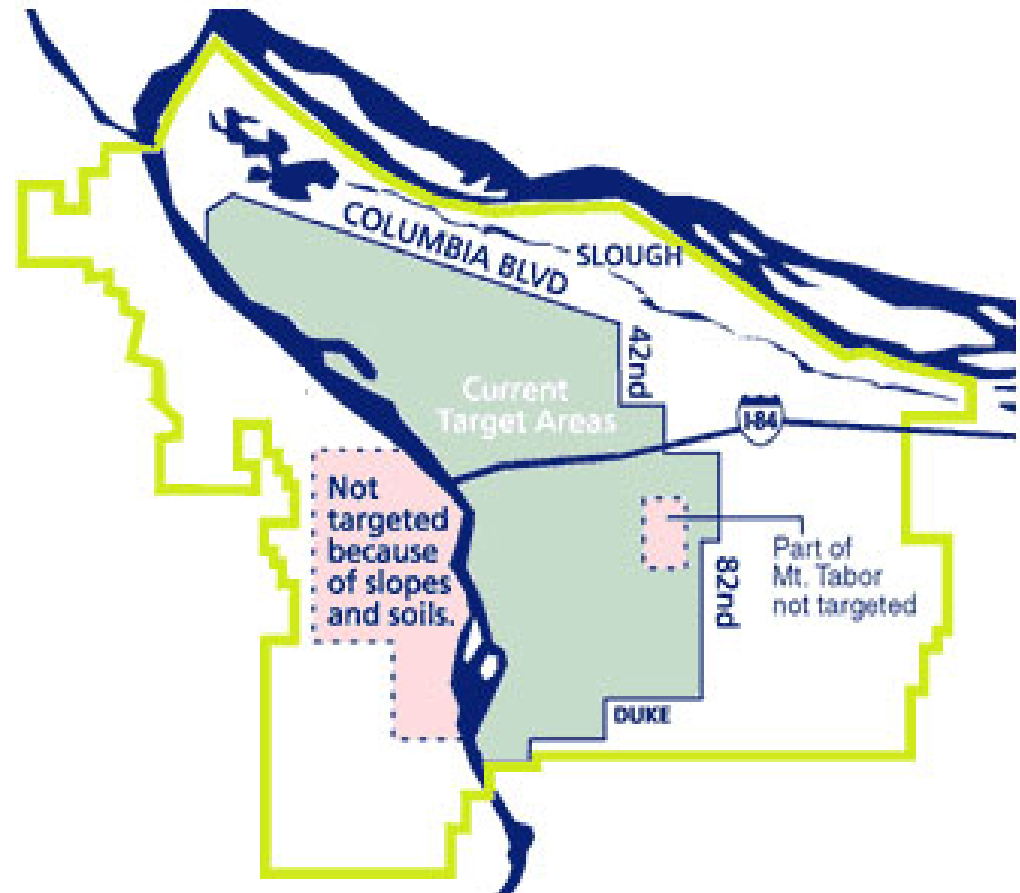

Downspout Disconnection Program

- Applies to sites in target area only
- Reduces stormwater to eastside CSO pipes
- City will do FREE work **OR**
- Call the program to learn how property owners can earn up to \$53 per downspout that meets program standards.

Treebate Program

Planting trees helps reduce stormwater runoff

- Purchase an eligible tree(s)
 - Trunk must be 1" in diameter
 - Most trees are eligible (see website for conditions)
- Tree must be planted at a **Residence** in City limits
 - Single family or multi-family up to 4 units
- Submit receipt and Treebate form
 - 50% of the cost is covered, up to \$40 (up to \$50 for native trees)
 - Credit is reflected on utility bill



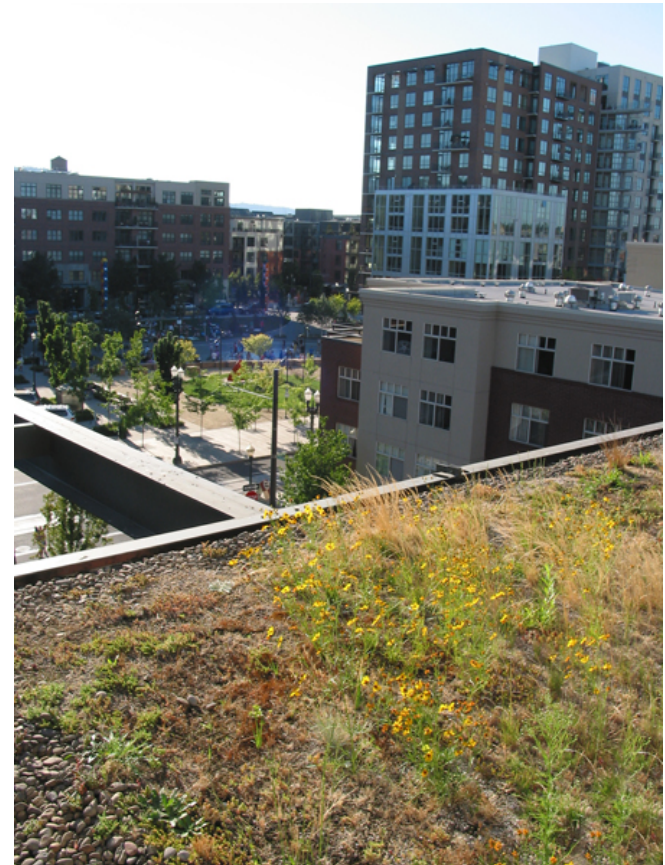

Ecoroof Incentive Program

Ecoroof: A light weight vegetated roof system that reduces runoff, improves air quality, provides wildlife habitat, saves energy, and lasts longer than a conventional roof.

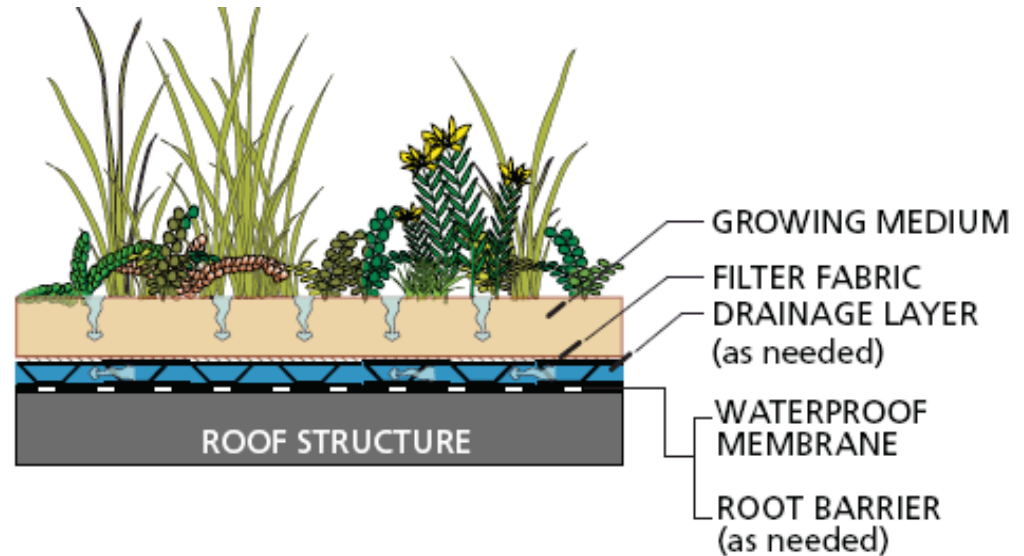

Ecoroof Incentive Program

- Ecoroofs capture and evaporate up to 60% of the rain that falls on them
- Applicable for all types of buildings
- Doubles the life-span of the roof
- Cost from \$5-\$20 per square foot
- Incentive of up to \$5 per square foot available
- Compatible with solar energy systems
- Optimal to consider when replacing your existing roof

BES CWSP Grants

Community Watershed Stewardship Program

- Offers up to \$10,000 for watershed improvement projects including:
 - Stormwater Retrofit projects
 - Natural area restoration projects
 - Naturescaping projects
 - Education or monitoring projects
- Projects should include educational value, community partnerships, innovation or meet a defined public need
- More likely to fund projects at publicly accessible sites (educational or religious institutions) or larger properties with potential community engagement
- Native Plant Mini-grants (up to \$300) are also available
