



Office space now available at Ecumenical Ministries of Oregon's historic Patton Home

The Rodney Page Community Ministries Center occupies the entire third floor of the historic Patton Home, located within walking distance of Portland's trendy N. Mississippi restaurants and shops. If you are looking for office space, this is for you!

Completely renovated in 2007, the Center features:

- Six individual offices of approximately 280 square feet each, including storage
- Common areas include a reception area, conference room, break room with kitchenette, and restrooms
- \$300/month per office with all utilities included (forced air heat and central air conditioning)
- Convenient I-5 freeway access (Alberta/Killingsworth exit)
- Free on-street parking
- Separate secure street entrance with elevator access
- Views of downtown Portland from select offices

About the Patton Home: Established in 1887, the Patton Home originally served as a retirement home, offering shelter and care for those in need. During the late 1990s, EMO acquired this historic site. After a \$6 million renovation, EMO initially operated the Patton Home as a licensed Residential Care Facility. The Patton Home has now transitioned to serve a drug- and alcohol-free, low-income population in a single-room occupancy (SRO) facility. The Community Ministries Center occupies the third floor of the building, providing office space for community groups and organizations.
