2009: The Year of Reconciliation

Jesus said, "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called the children of God." In the midst of a world torn by war, local and domestic violence, we look to leaders to guide us to be the peacemakers we are called to be.

In 2009, we were blessed with the powerful and inspirational presence of Archbishop Desmond Tutu for Ecumenical Ministries of Oregon's (EMO) **Collins Lecture**, "The Transformative Power of Reconciliation in Society." The retired Anglican Archbishop of Cape Town, South Africa, and world renowned human rights activist and Nobel Laureate spoke to over 8,000 people at the University of Portland while a statewide audience followed him on Oregon Public Broadcasting. With humor and honesty, Archbishop Tutu powerfully shared his belief in the power of forgiveness and inspired hundreds of young and old Oregonians.


Meanwhile, 2009 continued to present severe economic challenges. Many in our state and country suffered hunger, homelessness and unemployment. EMO's 2009 **Interfaith Advocacy Day** focused on the vital issues of health care, affordable housing and hunger relief in this troubled economy. Meanwhile EMO's **Northeast Emergency Food Program**, **HIV Day Center**, **Patton Home** and **Shared Housing** ministries served record numbers of people in need.

In a year when the nation's health care was a high priority, EMO's **Oregon Interfaith Health Justice Campaign** provided the catalyst around which communities of faith became involved in the discussion and creation of health care reform. In another vital initiative, EMO's **Interfaith Food & Farms Partnership** (IFFP) joined faith-based coalitions across the nation to launch a campaign funded through the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation to engage faith communities in promoting children's health and combating childhood obesity.

Along with these accomplishments, 2009 brought national honors to EMO. The National Council of Churches and Church World Service honored EMO Executive Director David Leslie with the Eugene Carson Blake Award for "welcoming outreach to those beyond the bounds of ecumenism," honoring leaders who "deepen the kinship of Christians of every race and nation."

As we go forward, we continue to work toward the vision of the Beloved Community that the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. described in *Where Do We Go From Here*: "We have inherited a large house, a great "world house" in which we have to live together—black and white, Easterner and Westerner, Gentile and Jew, Catholic and Protestant, Muslim and Hindu—a family unduly separated in ideas, culture and interest, who, because we can never again live apart, must learn somehow to live with each other in peace." As we in EMO serve together in faith, we strive to make real this important gospel commitment in our state and in the world.

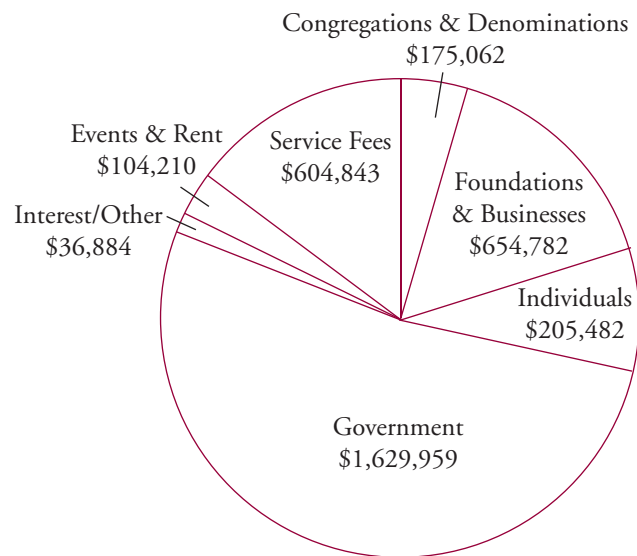

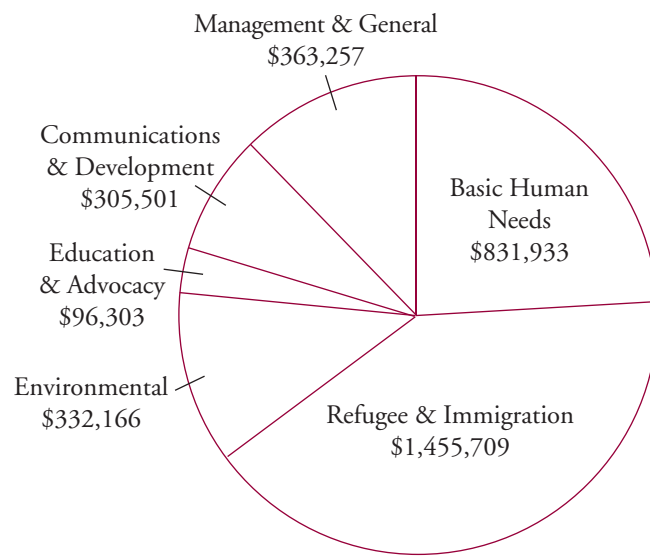

Hunger, Nutrition & Social Support

Serving communities in crisis and people in need is central to EMO's basic human needs programs, which are listed below.

Food Services/Delizioso Catering prepares nutritious meals for clients at the HIV Day Center and Daily Bread Express, residents at the Patton Home and students at local schools. The program also runs a catering service, providing outstanding and affordable food for events.

HIV Services offers a wide range of assistance for people living with HIV/AIDS. The HIV Day Center provides meals, counseling, recreational therapy, computers, phones, laundry, clothing and showers. The Daily Bread Express is the only program in Portland that delivers hot and frozen meals to home-bound individuals living with HIV/AIDS.

Northeast Emergency Food Program (NEFP) provides nutritionally-balanced food for people in critical need and works to develop neighborhood-based solutions to secure access to adequate, affordable and healthy foods.

Hunger, Nutrition and Social Support in 2009 ...

Food Services/Delizioso Catering prepared approximately 150 meals each day for students at five schools, residents at the Patton Home, and clients of the Daily Bread Express and HIV Day Center, totaling more than 68,000 meals for the year ■ **HIV Day Center and Daily Bread Express** served 281 clients; 7,206 visits were made to the HIV Day Center; 18,702 meals were provided, 9,819 of which were delivered directly to clients' homes ■ **Northeast Emergency Food Program** provided a five-day supply of food and household supplies to 7,469 families, representing 22,437 individuals, the highest is the program's 25-year history; opened satellite program at Genesis Community Fellowship.

Portland International Community School (PICS) provides culturally-relevant education in collaboration with Portland Public Schools for refugee, immigrant and first generation high school students.

Russian Oregon Social Services (ROSS) gives assistance to Russian-speaking refugees and immigrants, including domestic violence services, breast health education, mental health counseling, ESL and computer classes, citizenship training, legal and tax assistance, dental care and more.

Sponsors Organized to Assist Refugees (SOAR) offers legal services and provides resettlement and comprehensive services to refugees through church and other sponsorships, including asylum coordination.

■ *Sponsors Organized to Assist Refugees (SOAR) resettled 213 refugees from Afghanistan, Burma, Cuba, the Former Soviet Union, Iran, Iraq, Nepal, Somalia and Vietnam; began Youth Mentoring Program and expanded services to Burmese youth* ■ *SOAR Immigration/Legal Services filed 123 applications for permanent residency, 140 for work permits and 17 for U.S. citizenship; Cuban-Haitian funding doubled, providing more self sufficiency support.*
